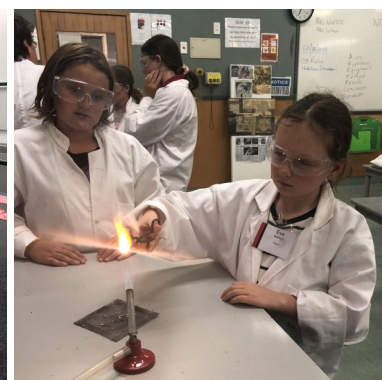
The students also got to experience Medieval Softball and Crab Soccer in PE, played games in Maōri which taught them the use of left, right, forwards and backwards.

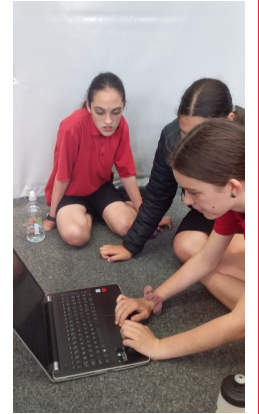
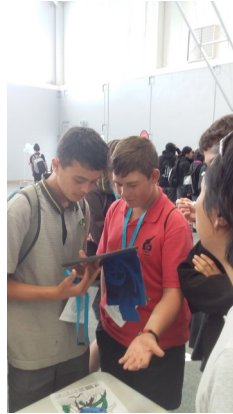
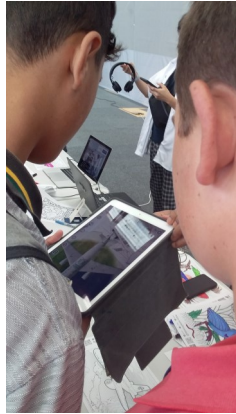
