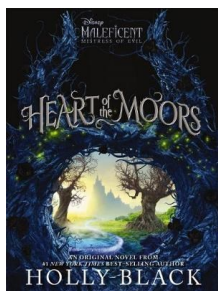

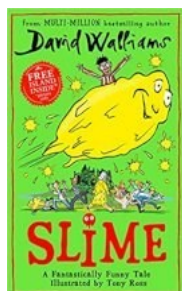
2019 CALF CLUB TROPHIES need to be returned to the Primary asap so we can get them engraved prior to this year's event.

Library News

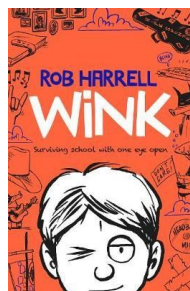
